

Dynamics of changes in symptoms, quality of live and prostate volume see below




Clinical Trial: The dynamics of chronic prostatitis symptoms in 45 men



Pain decreased significantly, measured by the NIH-CPSI score. The decrease in pain with the use of Dr Allen's Device is much higher than in the control group.


Clinical Trial: The dynamics of the chronic prostatitis symptoms in 45 men
